Comments

Speaking & Listening

Reading & Phonics

In reading and phonics, Awa and Kan have been working on decoding words with more than one syllable and improving recognition of common sight words. They display strong foundational phonics skills and read with growing accuracy and expression. They are willing to read aloud and often make group reading sessions lively and enjoyable. To continue progressing, they should focus on refining their reading accuracy and fluency, particularly with more complex words, while maintaining their confidence and animated delivery. Continued phonics and reading practice at home will be beneficial.

Grammar & Writing

Awa and Kan's current grammar and writing focus has been on understanding and using verbs, nouns, adjectives, and pronouns, as well as developing clear sentence structure. They demonstrate awareness of grammatical elements and can identify parts of speech within sentences. Writing tasks are completed with enthusiasm and often a creative twist that reflects their personalities. To improve further, they should continue reviewing grammar rules and applying them in their written work, aiming for accuracy, variety, and clarity while keeping their unique voices.

Personal Expression & Conversation

Awa and Kan excel in personal expression, often sharing stories about their hobbies, interests, and everyday experiences with humor and confidence. This approach not only builds fluency but also makes classroom discussions lively and engaging for everyone. They are never shy to speak, often sparking laughter and energy in the room. To make further progress, they are encouraged to balance their high energy with focus during open discussions and to use new vocabulary in context as much as possible.
