Speaking & Listening

Tieweed listens attentively to instructions and stories, demonstrating good comprehension. Reading & Phonics

While her grammar is generally sound, she occasionally forgets verb tenses or articles. Encouragement to reread and edit her work will help strengthen accuracy. We are working steadily through grammar stage 2 to ensure full understanding of basic sentence and question structures.

Personal Expression & Conversation

She is imaginative and enjoys sharing her ideas with others. Tieweed expresses herself well in casual conversations and enjoys storytelling activities. She is able to talk about her own interests and gives good context when describing situations. She is able to describe situations. Overall Strengths
