### Student Report: Ikkyu and View – Year 5

#### **Speaking & Listening:**

#### **Personal Expression & Conversation:**

Ikkyu and View enjoy participating in conversations and class discussions when encouraged. They are gradually becoming more comfortable sharing their ideas and opinions in English. As their vocabulary expands, they are beginning to express themselves more naturally and confidently. Continued practice in everyday English conversation will further strengthen their fluency and comfort.

#### **Overall Strengths:**

Both Ikkyu and View are kind, enthusiastic learners who bring a positive attitude to class. Their reading progress and growing confidence are clear strengths, and their willingness to try new language activities helps them continue improving.

#### **Recommendations for Improvement:**

Ikkyu and View should continue following the course closely and previewing upcoming lessons and books on the website. Maintaining focus during class and keeping a consistent study routine will help them make steady monthly progress. Regular reading and short daily writing exercises will also reinforce their growing language skills.
