Comments

Speaking & Listening

Reading & Phonics

Peach has strong potential in conversation and personal expression. When he is fully engaged, he is able to share thoughtful opinions and participate in meaningful discussions with classmates. Recently, he has shown growing confidence when expressing his ideas, and continued participation will help him develop even greater fluency and confidence.
