Comments

Pluemjai, Al, and Chaaim are three lovely Year 5 students who bring a positive and enthusiastic attitude to their lessons. They are very bright and consistently show potential through the quality of their contributions. Their cheerful nature and willingness to learn make them a pleasure to teach.

Speaking & Listening

The girls listen attentively during lessons and respond well when asked questions. At times, they give excellent answers that demonstrate strong understanding. To make even greater progress, it would be helpful if they kept their sound on more consistently during lessons, as this will give them more opportunities to practice speaking and listening actively.

Reading & Phonics

Their reading skills are developing steadily, and they are able to follow texts at an appropriate level for Year 5. With continued practice, they will become more fluent and confident readers, able to show greater expression and comprehension.

Grammar & Writing

At this stage, the girls have a decent understanding of grammar and are able to construct sentences accurately. They are showing progress in applying grammar rules and can continue to improve by practicing more extended writing tasks.

Personal Expression & Conversation

Pluemjai, Al, and Chaaim all demonstrate confidence in expressing themselves when encouraged. They enjoy sharing their ideas and are beginning to show more creativity in their conversations. Consistent use of their microphones would allow them to participate more freely and build fluency.

Overall Strengths

The group shows brightness, enthusiasm, and a solid grasp of grammar for their level. They give excellent answers at times and display a thoughtful approach to their work.

Recommendations for Improvement

It is recommended that they continue following their course on the Universal English Academy website to support their progress. They should also make a greater effort to keep their sound on and speak regularly in class, as this will strengthen their fluency, confidence, and overall communication skills.
