Speaking & Listening

Kef is now a very confident speaker who enjoys participating in class discussions. He is able to express his ideas clearly and naturally, often using a wide range of vocabulary to communicate effectively. He listens carefully during lessons and responds thoughtfully, showing strong comprehension of spoken English. His confidence and willingness to speak allow him to practise and strengthen his communication skills regularly.

Reading & Phonics

Grammar & Writing

However, these mistakes do not prevent him from expressing his ideas clearly. With more regular attention to grammar practice and careful review of his work, his already strong communication skills will become even more accurate and polished.

Personal Expression & Conversation

Kef expresses himself with confidence and ease in both formal and informal conversation. He shows creativity when sharing ideas and is comfortable engaging in discussions on a variety of topics. He is occasionally limited by his vocabulary but this is really getting better. As he becomes more aware of grammar rules, he's able to speak in more detail about situations. His natural communication ability and strong vocabulary make him a strong contributor to group activities and classroom conversations.

Overall Strengths

Kef is a confident and fluent speaker with a wide and growing vocabulary. His enthusiasm for participating in discussions and his ability to communicate ideas clearly are significant strengths. Combined with his positive attitude and steady progress, these qualities allow him to perform strongly across his English studies. Kef often practices and repeats vocabulary and sentences, I always encourage this. Kef tells me when he's unsure about something which is very helpful for me and helps us both understand the class more.

What if I can't make it to class? Can I cancel?

- In the event of an emergency and you need to cancel a class, please tell me **24 hours before** our lesson. Cancellation can be done via Line message or through website chat. You can cancel a maximum of 'Three Times' per course unless you have informed me of a trip or other arrangement prior.
- If you cancel **within 24 hours**, I would not have time to replace my loss of time and scheduled arrangement therefore **the class will be deducted.**
